



DIAL AN ARTIST – INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUSLAN CALLERS

Got a curly problem that needs a creative solution?

Dial An Artist is a live art project running as part of the Melbourne Fringe Festival that will connect you to a dedicated hotline of artists who are ready to offer their answer to whatever problem you throw at them. Do your socks need mending? Want to overthrow the patriarchy? Thinking about calling your ex, or just not sure when to plant your tomatoes? Trust the wisdom of an artist – there's no problem too big or small!

The wonderful Jodee Mundy OAM and Mademoiselle Coco will be solving problems in Auslan via video call from 12 – 8pm on each Monday of the Festival (that's 16 and 23 November!)

To solve your problem via video call in Auslan, please:

- Text 0492 932 105 on 16 November between 12 – 8pm AEST to speak to Jodee Mundy; or
- Text 0492 803 878 on 23 November between 12 – 8pm AEST to speak to Mademoiselle Coco.

In your text message to the artist, we ask that you please:

- Tell the artist whether you would prefer to receive a video call via FaceTime or WhatsApp (if it's WhatsApp – please ensure you download the app on your phone!)
- Provide a time window that you are available to receive a video call in Auslan
- Once you've sent the text, all you'll need to do is to be patient and wait for the artist to call!

Bring your problems, questions, curiosities or concerns – but please note this is a telephone art project and not a mental health support service. For crisis counselling, please call Lifeline on 13 11 14.

Please note: You will need to participate in this project by using your personal mobile. The artists are both using a one time mobile number for this project. Rest assured, your details will not be stored or recorded by the artists or Melbourne Fringe.
