

Venue Hire Info: Shows & Gigs about hiring Common Rooms

Fringe Common Rooms is more than just a venue for hire – it's a home for vibrant and groundbreaking independent arts, music and events.

All year round Common Rooms carries the torch for Melbourne Fringe's deep commitment to rebellion, inclusivity and creativity (and ripper dance floors, obvz).

From gigs and live music to comedy, spoken word, theatre, cabaret, parties and meet-ups – whatever you're up to, this is fully accessible common ground for everyone. And for artists, it's a chance to share your work in a bustling and historic building right in the heart of Melbourne – and cos we love artists, you get heaps of benefits!

Fringe Common Rooms at Trades Hall consists of two spaces:

Ballroom: a performance space & bar that holds up to 176 patrons standing or 114 seated theatre-style. Perfect for your event or performance (think comedy, cabaret, spoken word), dance party, book launch or film screening.

Lounge: a second, intimate saloon-style space that holds up to 76 people standing or 48 seated and is ideal for workshops, meetings and rehearsals.

Porque no los dos? For most events in the Ballroom, the Lounge can be used as a break-out area or backstage green room at no extra cost.

Common Rooms holds a 3am licence on all days except Sunday (which is licenced until 11pm). We have a bar in the Ballroom that we can run during your event; a minimum spend may apply.

Across both spaces there are 8x cabaret tables, 6x high bar tables and chairs and 130 theatre seats available to use.

HIRING COMMON ROOMS FOR YOUR SHOW/GIG

Reckon Common Rooms is the perfect place for your event? Fill out the <u>Expression of Interest form</u> on our website and tell us all about it. Our team meets regularly to assess proposals against the following criteria:

- **Suitability** Events that fit the space technically and physically.
- Community Works by independent artists that foster connection and celebrate our community, creating a social atmosphere.
- **Diversity** We value work by and for people who identify as LGBTIQ, First Nations, Deaf, disabled or Culturally or Linguistically Diverse.

- Viability Experience of the team, knowledge of the market and capacity to find an audience.
- Distinctiveness Unique events that explore new ideas in new ways, or that hold a distinctive place in Melbourne's arts market.

HIRE MODELS

Door split: Where the artist and Melbourne Fringe share the box office income (70% to you, 30% to us). Includes a dedicated technical staff member for five hours (including any rehearsal or bump-in time). Suitable for independent arts one-off shows and seasons of work where there is some level of tech involved. There is a minimum hire fee to ensure that some of the costs of opening the venue can be covered.

Minimum spend: Where there is a minimum spend on the bar that the event must meet, or the Hirer pays the difference. This is to minimise outright costs for hirers while ensuring we can keep the venue financially sustainable. Suitable for social events, DJ nights, other gigs and parties. Any technical or door staff will be on-charged at a per hour rate.

Flat venue-hire: Where there's a flat rate for the venue hire, plus labour costs. The rate will change depending on the day of the week, how long the hire period is for, and whether the bar is open. Suitable for free or daytime events, rehearsals and long-term hires.

All hires include a dedicated venue staff member who is your go-to for making your event a success. We'll work with you to determine the most suitable hire model.

TICKETING

As a rule, all tickets must be sold through Melbourne Fringe's ticketing system. We'll work with you to set your ticket prices and manage any special ticketing requirements. No matter the type of venue hire, all tickets attract a scaled inside charge per ticket sold to cover the cost of the ticketing system.

GST is not applicable to inside charges.



Please note Fringe Common Rooms is a licenced venue, and as such all minors on the premises must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Underage or youth events restricted to a particular age group (under 18 or under 25) may be permitted in certain circumstances where there is no bar service. If you are looking to host an underage or youth event get in touch with our team with plenty of advance notice.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

Both spaces are fully kitted out for your show or gig (see full tech specs below) so we're 100% ready to help you realise your vision.

Events with a door split arrangement include a dedicated venue technician for up to five hours to operate your show.

All other events receive our basic tech set-up and support as part of the venue hire cost. Basic tech set up is microphone and PA, aux cord to plug in a music device and a pre-set lighting state. Basic technical support means someone will turn the house lights down, house music down, mic up, lights up. If you want to arrange your own technician to operate your performance, talk to us.

If you need anything more complex than this you can arrange to bring your own technician (who must be inducted by a Melbourne Fringe staff member prior to the event), or use one of our expert venue technicians. Costs for venue technicians and door staff are as follows: Up and including to 8 hours: \$40 incl. GST More than 8 hours: \$70 incl. GST Work between 12am-7am: \$70 incl. GST Sunday (all day): \$70 incl. GST

ACCESS AND INCLUSION

Fringe Common Rooms is committed to being a wholly inclusive and accessible venue. No more shunting people into out-of-the-way goods lifts – Trades Hall's recent renovations means the entire venue is accessible, with a brand-new platform lift from Lygon Street and an internal lift right near the entrance to the venue.

Newly installed gender-neutral and accessible bathrooms are just down the hall. There's also a hearing loop and portable wheelchair lift to make the stage accessible. Let us know if there's anything else you need and we'll make it happen.
