

Builders Arms Hotel visual guide

Builders Arms Hotel is located on the corners of Gore & Gertrude streets in Fitzroy – map address 211 Gertrude Street, Fitzroy.

Accessibility

The Builders Arms Hotel ground level has an accessible entry and ramps throughout the venue. There is some stairs but can be avoided with another route.

The Bowery Room is not accessible.

There is a bathroom in the courtyard with enough space to be accessible but there is no pole to assist.

Public Transport

Tram

The 86 tram (line from Bundoora – Docklands) stops 400m from the main entrance to the pub.

The 11 tram (line from West Preston - Victoria Harbour) stops 450m from the main entrance of the Pub.

Train

There is no train close to the Builders Arms Hotel. The closest station is Collingwood and is 1.3km away from the Pub.

Bus

Routes 246, 302, 905, 906, 907 run down Victoria Parade, a 300m walk from the Pub.

Parking

There is no car park at the Builders Arms Hotel and the streets surrounding are either timed or permit and not always available.

Car parks we recommend are Ace Parking – located at Smith Street Coles. Enter via Peel/Oxford Street. There is disabled parking and lift access. It is 400m away from the main entrance of the Pub.

Secure parking ACU – Located next to the Australian Catholic University at 115 Victoria Parade, Fitzroy. There is disabled parking and lift access. It is located 500m from the main entrance of the Pub.
