





## STREET PARTY - SUNDAY OCTOBER 1ST

midday - 8pm

The biggest alternative event on Melbourne's calendar returns to officially launch the 2000 Melbourne Fringe Festival. This year's event aims to give you a taste of what the Festival as a whole has to offer in the coming weeks. With slices of the Fringe Outdoor Program, Architecture, Furniture, Visual Arts and more. 2000 sees an expansion of the Street Party encompassing more of Johnston St and running all the way from Alexandra Pde to Gertrude St - over a kilometre of entertainment! Everything from cabaret to techno, circus to comedy.

## FEATURES OF THE DAY

### PARADE

Anything goes (or almost goes) which is why the course runs downhill all the way to Alexandra Pde. Melbourne's wackiest races, the open access parade features input from Fringe artists, bands, local traders, the community and random overly excited members of the public. Come early for this huge exhibition of subcultural delights. (From King William St to Alexandra Pde, starting at 1pm.)

### WAITERS RACE

See your favourite waiter risk death and injury to deliver the freshest and best coffee on the street. Each waiter will tackle the complex and crazy obstacle course to demonstrate once and for all that it takes a finely tuned athlete, focussed in mind and body to carry the title: "Brunswick Street Waiter". Waiters race - going for gold at the intersection of Johnston and Brunswick Streets - 3pm.

### SCULPTURE RACE OR ODE TO THE YELLOW PERIL

Brunswick St Traders take on the Fringe in a display of high speed creativity and ingenuity. Two teams, one hungry for funding, the other hungry for the taxman's blood let it all out in a frenzy of creative juices, with the aim of building a symbol for the new millennium and our wonderful new tax system. (Fringe Stage 4pm)

### WINDOWS PROGRAM IN ASSOCIATION WITH BRUNSWICK STREET TRADERS

Installations by Fringe artists in participating Traders' windows. This project will commence a fortnight out, and continue throughout the Festival. Highlighting the diversity of wares available on Brunswick St, and offerings in the Festival as a whole. Performances in some windows will occur on the day, and the following two Sundays. (Random locations all day).

### FRINGE BAR

Open all day on Johnston St, the site for the Waiters Race, Sculpture Race and inaugural Fitzroy Running of the Bulls, the Fringe bar and arena is the place to be on this wonderful day.

### HAIRCUT OLYMPICS



