How to get there

Please meet with Front of House staff at the Trades Hall courtyard. They will scan your ticket and guide you to The Square.

- PTV
 - Tram
 - The nearest tram stop is Queensberry St/Swanston St.
 - Tram routes 1, 3, 5, 6, 16, 64, 67 and 72 all stop here.
 - It is 400m (approx. 6 minute walk) to Trades Hall
 - Train
 - The nearest train station is Melbourne Central.
 - It is 600m (approx. 8 minute walk) to Trades Hall.
 - Bus
 - The 200 and 207 buses stop in front of Trades Hall on Lygon St
- Parking
 - Bike Spots
 - Bike parking is available in front of Trades Hall on Lygon St.
 - Car Spots
 - There are metered 2hr parking spots along Lygon St, Queensberry St, and Victoria St. There is also unmetered 2hr parking in Cardigan St.
 - Parking can be limited in the evenings. Please allow plenty of time if you are planning to drive.
- Drop Off Spots
 - Taxi/Ride Share Drop Off Points are available on Lygon St

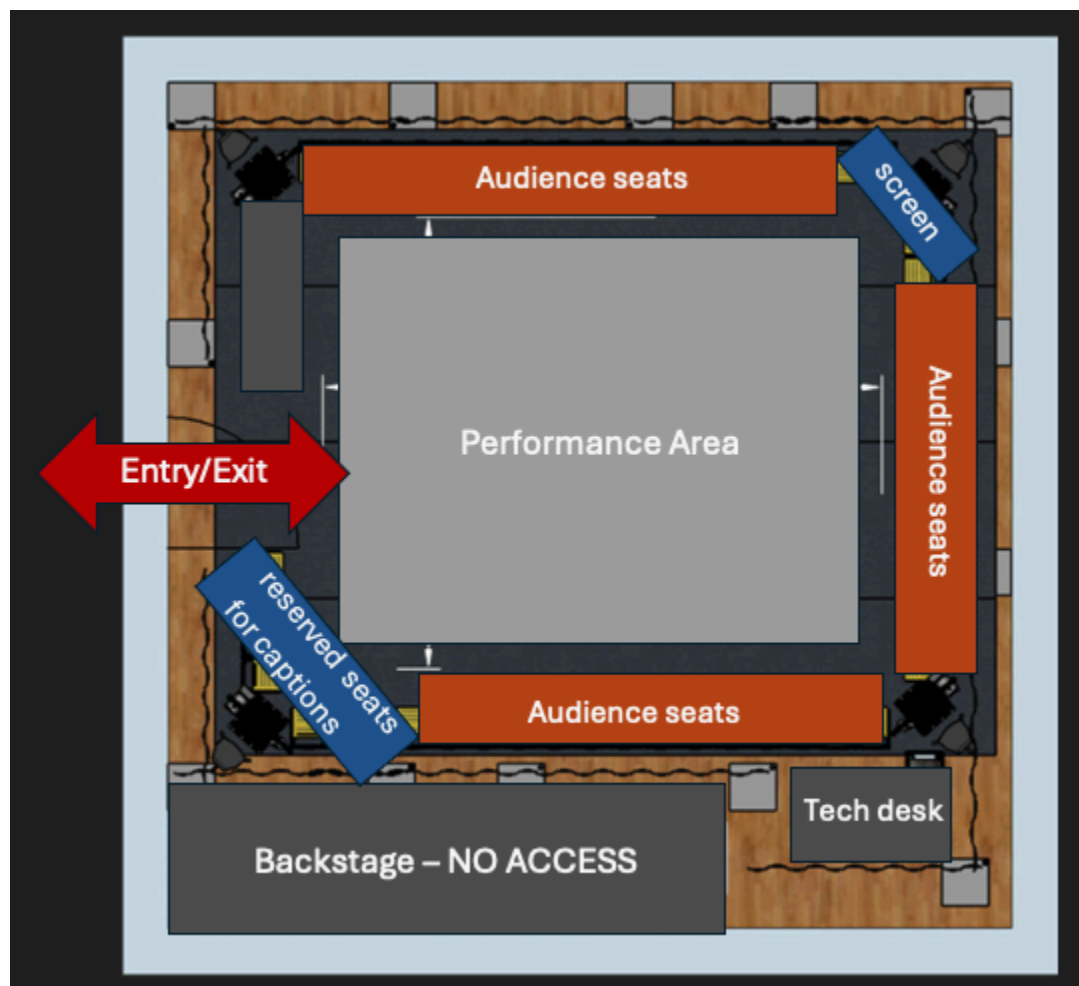
