Doors to all event spaces will open at **8:30pm**, including the social space and outdoor terrace. They will close at **12:30am**.

Tactile Tours will also begin at **8:30pm** for anyone who has registered.

## **Sensory Elements**

## Supper Room, Basement

- **Sound:** There will be consistent sound throughout the event. This includes performances, singing, MC dialogue and dance music. The music will occasionally fade in and out across the night and between performance acts. At times the music might be quite loud. At times the performers and Auslan interpreters may be voicing over music or background noise. There will also be talking and noise from party guests attending.
- Lighting: Coloured lighting that may fade between different warm and cool tones
  and go onto the stage, and into the room on the audience. Each act will have a
  different lighting state. Sometimes the stage may be bright spotlight or wash and
  the lights on the audience will go low. There is no projection or screens in the
  space. There will be no strobes or flashing lights.
- Physical: Vibration will be felt from the music. There may be potential for physical interaction between the audiences as everyone can freely move around throughout the event. At times, performers may be roving in the party space during their acts. There will be Air Purifiers in the space and air conditioning so you might feel moving air on your skin. The floors are smooth and flat surface.
- **Smell:** There is no use of scent in the party or any acts.
- Visual: There will be a bar in the space, a small 4m x 3m stage, and DJ
  equipment. The stage will have a red velvet backdrop and tinsel curtain.
   Performers will use an assortment of props for their acts including: a whip, flowers,

angel grinder, bed of nails, hoola hoop, and a light writer. One of the performers will be dressed up in a coocoo costume.

## Social Space, Level 1

- Sound: Ambient music will play in this space and the sound of people chatting.
- Lighting: The lighting in the social space upstairs will be soft mood lighting.
- Physical: The social space upstairs will contain a range of soft furnishings, beanbags and soft sculpture artworks that can be touched and interacted with. This includes two large glove shaped textile works with pillows which patrons can physically get into a lay down in. The terrace is outdoors and has no cover from the natural environment and weather.
- **Smell:** There is no use of scent in this space.
- Visual: A series of Amy's soft sculptural artworks will be installed in this space.
   These soft sculptures replace traditional medical tools, subverting established medical environments' cold and sterile nature.

There are two large body-sized medical gloves with accompanying pillows. You are welcome to physically get inside these gloves and lay down. The inside of both gloves is lined with soft velvet.

An assortment of medical tools, including a thermometer, pills, and pill bottles, will be placed around the space. You're welcome to touch these items, cuddle them, or rest on them gently. Each piece is handmade and not designed for heavy use, so please don't throw or jump on them. You can use the pills as a stimming tool, but they must stay in the studio.

A large circular quilt will be hung in the space and can be viewed from both sides. Each side features different colours, materials, and phrases. This artwork cannot be touched.

## **Outdoor Terrace, Level 1**

- Sound: There may be ambient sound and street noise.
- Lighting: There are several strings of light globes elevated in this space as well as
  four outdoor lights that provide an ambient glow. You may also see streetlights as
  the terrace is above George Johnson Lane.
- Physical: This is an open-air terrace, you may feel the elements on your skin.
- **Smell:** You may smell some of the herbs in the planter boxes or other ambient scents that the wind carries from the street and surrounding buildings.
- Visual: The courtyard has planter boxes, and an assortment of outdoor chairs and tables.

# **Audience Experience**

## **Entry to spaces**

## **Supper Room, Basement Level**

The main party room is located in the Supper Room in the Basement.

## Access to the space:

- The Supper Room can be accessed either via lift or stairs from the foyer area.
- There are 20 stairs to the Supper Room with grab rails either side. Please note the staircase is wide, so grab rails are not able to be used on both sides at the same time. The staircase also has a low archway, so please be alert to ensure you avoid injury.
- Entry to Supper Room is through a glass door which is 150cm wide

## **Terrace, Level 1**

The outdoor Terrace will be open for people to get fresh air and socialize.

## Access to the space:

- The terrace can be accessed either via lift or stairs from the foyer area.
- The stairs to Level 1 have grab rails on either side. Please note this staircase is very wide, so grab rails are not able to be used on both sides at the same time.

## Social Space, Level 1

The social space includes artwork by Amy Claire Mills and an assortment of bean bags.

## Access to the space:

- Studio 1 can be accessed either via lift or stairs from the foyer area.
- The stairs to Level 1 have grab rails on either side. Please note this staircase is very wide, so grab rails are not able to be used on both sides at the same time.

## **Shocks or surprises**

Sarah Birdgirl will operate an angle grinder in her act and lay on a bed of nails. Kitty Obsidian's act involves cracking a flower with a whip that is positioned between their assistant's hand, mouth and legs. Thomas Banks act involves inviting someone from the audience to operate his communication device.

## **Audience expectations**

Sam Martin and Nathan Borg's act will commence on the dance floor amongst audience members and they may be in close proximity to you.

All other acts will take place on the stage, and audiences can choose to experience the performances from any distance that is comfortable.

## **Social expectations**

Audiences are able to move freely around the space and across all levels. The DJs will play dance music in the Supper Room between each act, and you are welcome to dance in the space or socialise.

There will be a small number of high and low tables and chairs available in the Supper Room, and relaxed spaces in the foyer. The social space upstairs will have an assortment of bean bags and interactive artworks.

You are welcome to come and go as you please across all spaces, make noise, stim, and respond to the work for the duration of the event.

There is an optional dress-up competition all guests are welcome to take part in. Guests are invited to come to the party dressed up according to the four categories below.

Maybe you're feeling a little tactile or want to put your most sassiest outfit on. Or perhaps you'd rather blend into the crowd.

This will be hosted by the MCs Mademoiselle Coco and Jodee Mundy and involve coming up on stage for a short moment.

Categories are:

#### **Best Textured**

You're the most tactile person in the room, you're irresistible to touch

## **Armour Against Ableism**

You're a hero of community, nothing's going to get you down

## **Sexy Disabled Pride**

You're the epitome of sass and so hot you've got your own #hashtag

## **Ally**

You know it's not about you, but you always show up

No pre-registration is required to enter the competition.

It will commence at 10pm and winners take home an original print by Luke Duncan King.

## **Performance expectations**

During the performances, the co-hosts will introduce the artists and their acts. The co-hosts themselves will have an intro act and outro act. Thomas Banks performance involves a moment of invited interaction from one audience member. All other acts do not include interactive elements. The dress-up competition is optional and will involve a moment of coming up on stage and fashioning your outfit.

The main party entrance is via George Johnson Lane from Errol Street, North Mebourne. This entrance is wheelchair accessible and has grab rails either side.





All bathrooms have Dyson hand dryers with sensor activation. There is an accessible bathroom that is single use on ground level opposite the Quiet Space. There is another accessible bathroom upstairs – this is accessible via lift or stairs.
